- CryptoParty is a grassroots global endeavor to introduce the basics of practical cryptography to the general public.
- Might include technologies like:
 - TOR
 - PGP
 - Full Disk Encryption
 - VPN



History of CryptoParties

- CryptoParty was conceived in late August 2012 by an Australian privacy advocate in a casual Twitter conversation with computer security experts.
- Made famous when Wired reported in May 2014 that Edward Snowden organized a local CryptoParty at a small hackerspace in Honolulu six months before becoming known for leaking secret government documents.



Why CryptoParties?
